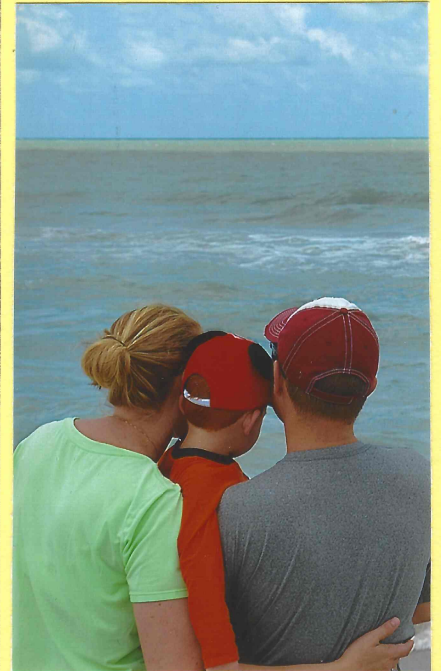
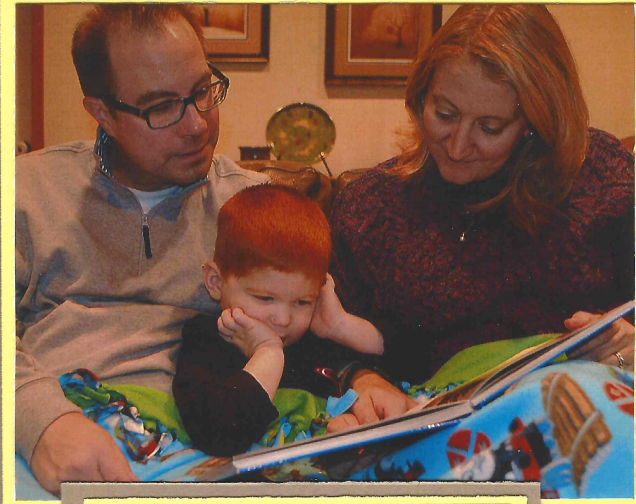
We are Corey, Marie, and Ian, and we are excited to share our lives with you through this profile, and for you to see how much we will love and cherish the baby placed in our family.

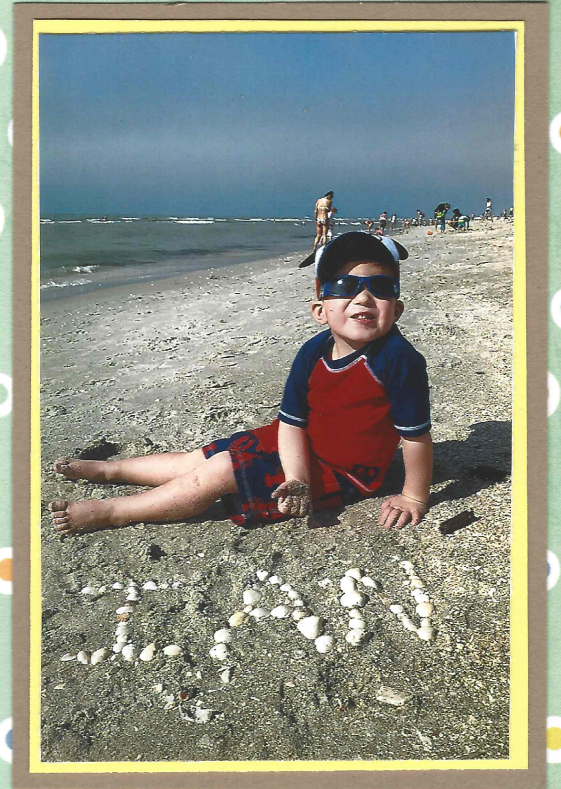


About Marie

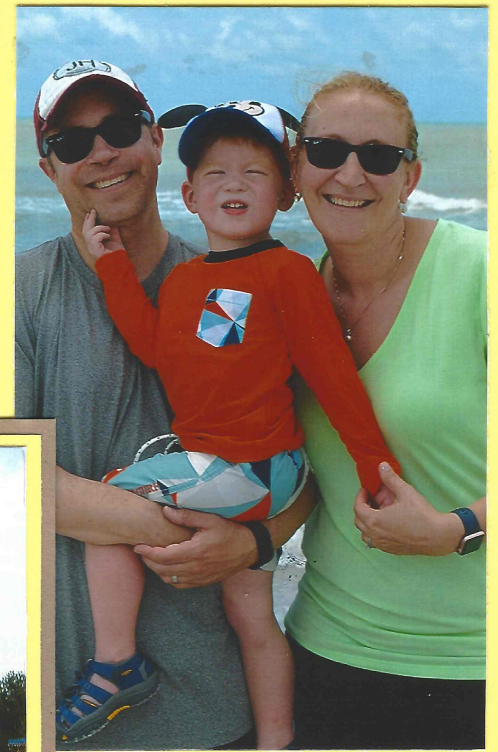
About Corey

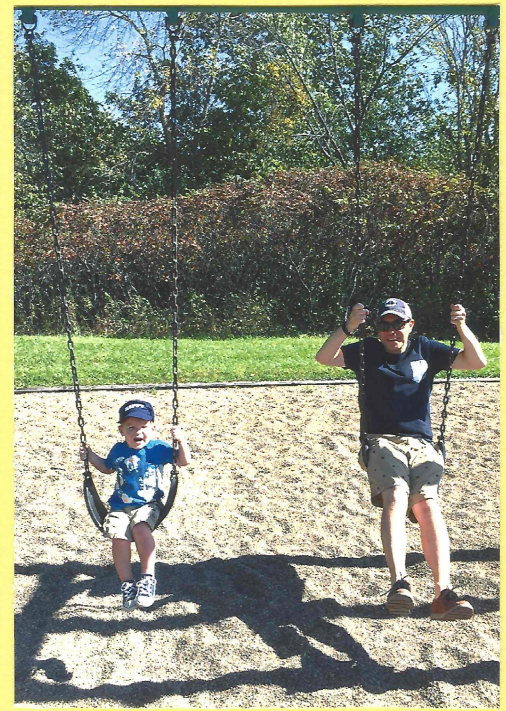
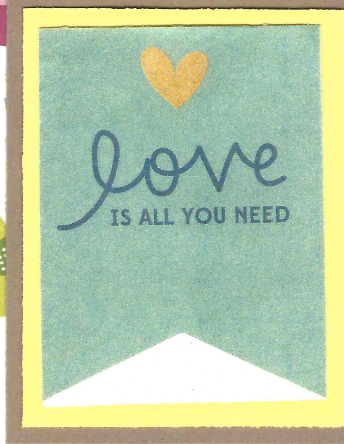
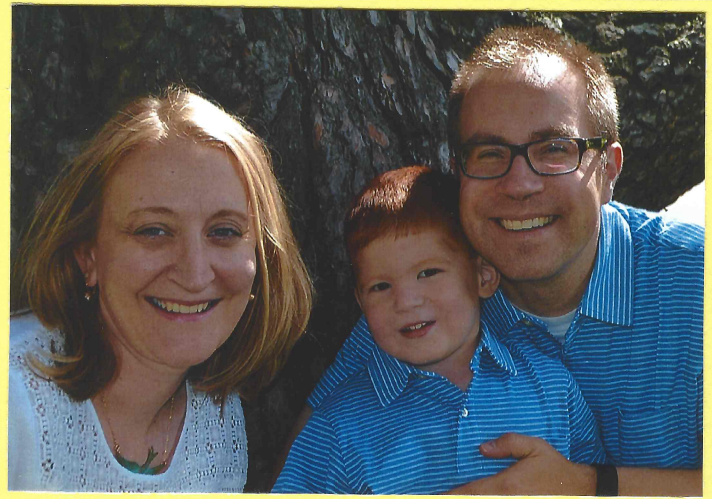
